INTRODUCTION

Camp Hendon is currently seeking enthusiastic and well-connected individuals to join our board of directors. We are going through an exciting period of program growth, and with that comes the need for additional community engagement, financial support, and strategic partnerships.

Camp Hendon's mission is to give children with diabetes life-changing experiences, empowering them to take control of their journey with diabetes. Camp Hendon serves children with Type 1 Diabetes in the Kentucky region through educational summer camp and other year round programming. Type 1 Diabetes (T1D) is a chronic, autoimmune disorder that is not the result of lifestyle or eating habits. During two weeks of summer camp every year, Camp Hendon equips children with the skills they need to manage their diabetes with more independence while also providing a community of peer support. Since 2012, Camp Hendon has served over 800 children with T1D between the ages of 8 to 17.

COMMITMENT & RESPONSIBILITIES

The Camp Hendon board of directors meets on a bi-monthly basis for approximately two hours. It is expected that members of the board will actively participate in and/or lead at least one sub-committee. Board members should be reachable, and communicative, via both email and phone. Camp Hendon's board members are expected to represent the organization in the community, and to continually seek opportunities to grow our base of supporters and partnerships. The length of term for a board member is two years, with an anticipated monthly time commitment of 10 hours. Board members are also expected to contribute a personally meaningful gift to the organization on an annual basis, in addition to achieving a personal fundraising goal of no less than \$500 through outside sources. Board members are asked to attend at least one day of our summer camp programs, and be active participants in our other year-round events.
